Dear Villa Resident of Fox Ridge Drive

Thank you to those residents that attended our informational meeting on Wednesday, 11 November 2015. There were 15 Villa owners in attendance. We had a wide ranging discussion including the history of the project, how the pavers would be installed and specific cost estimates already known.

There are a number of residents that continue to express interest in replacing their current concrete driveway with brick pavers. While the Architectural Review Board has already approved a “crème” paver, there is an interest in using a “red” paver instead.

Based on your response, we will finalize approval with the Architectural Review Board, complete the estimate and move forward with installation for those Villa owners that wish to install pavers. We would like all 42 Villa owners to vote regardless of whether you are interested in having pavers installed. With the Holidays approaching, we realize that many of you will be traveling. We would appreciate your vote by Friday, 20 November 2015.

As stated before, the decision to replace your concrete driveway with pavers is voluntary. If you have already decided that you will not replace your concrete driveway with pavers, we thought it appropriate to keep you informed as this is the paver that will be used going forward.
