Benches - Sondra Parmiter left information describing the various bench selections and also a magazine titled, Casual Country Teak. After some discussion and review of the designs in Sondra's package, we felt the design that pleased us was one from the magazine, which is similar to the bench Don Huprich had ordered. This bench is a polywood bench, 60 inches long, 24 inches deep and 35 inches high. It is of heavy duty construction of recycled HDPE and requires little maintenance. Price \$499.00 and free shipping. The fishing club has donated the money for one bench and hopefully a second bench will be purchased. The fishing club would like the bench to be placed across from the back gate. The location of this bench and any other will be approved by the beautification committee. The committee is not in favor of dedicated benches. Wendy has recommended that the bench be placed on pavers, which can be selected.

Benches at Silverthorn - these benches are in good shape. They need to be refurbished and will look good with a "facelift".
