

**HUNTERS RIDGE GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB  
SOCIAL COMMITTEE MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2014**

The meeting was called to order at 4PM by Co-Chairman, John Simoncini.

Members present: Sydell Nusbaum, Albert Perrotta, Jacqueline Gannucci, and Co-Chairman and Board Liaison, Dave Miller.

Member(s) absent: Suzanne Evans McMurtrie, who was out of town on business.

The minutes for the April 28, 2014 minutes were approved.

**Old Business:**

All members agreed that the entertainment and the Pot Luck events were well received.

Dinner Dance, October 25, 2014, The Ridge Opening, November 7, 2014, and the Welcome Back, November 18, 2014 were well attended and the entertainment was well received. It was noted that the Steel Drum performer at the The Ridge Opening would have been more acceptable if he had agreed to lighting the area, different location, more steel drum music versus tracks, and if there were more than one steel drum.

Bingo had an attendance of 30, Name That Tune had an attendance of 17, and Trivia had an attendance of 48. Sydell Nusbaum suggested cancelling Name That Tune for December and possibly hosting it only once a year due to poor attendance. That decision will be made in January, 2015.

**New Business:**

All members agreed that it would be a great idea to utilize The Ridge for more events. The Ridge opening was a huge success.

The hours of operation for The Ridge during the off season may not be our decision to make.

We will discuss at a later date entertainment for the 2015/2016 season. The possible construction of the dining room will have an impact on future social/entertainment events.

We will consider sponsoring more community type events in the future - having an ice cream social, Strawberry Festival, Ku Ku Trolley Ride, etc. The upcoming bus trip to attend an Everblades Hockey game will be the prototype. If events like the aforementioned are well received, we would consider continuing those non-entertainment events.

**Suggestions/Comments:**

It was agreed upon that it is the responsibility of the Social Committee to choose the entertainment for any event. We are always amenable to suggestions on entertainers, but the decision is ultimately up to the Social Committee.

Dave Miller will contact Ray, the Frank Sinatra impersonator, and John Simoncini will contact Jerry Dyke, for either of them to perform at The Ridge on December 10 or December 12, 2014.

It was suggested that Dave Miller will discuss with the House Committee the issues of correctly communicating events on the internet, on the television, and in the Scorecard, and also the new rule that tables cannot have more than 8 people. It seems at times events are misstated. It also appears that table size is not consistent. The reason is based solely on the fact that residents bring these issues to the Social Committee members.

Sydell Nusbaum suggested that she may need help with Bingo and/or Trivia, Dave Miller volunteered.

It was suggested, due to residents comments, that soft music be played during our dinner hour 5-6, and that the entertainment play from 6 – 9.
