



PLAYER'S GUIDE

- Hole #1** Tee Shot should favor Right Center of Fairway. Approx. 260 yards from tee to swale across middle of fairway. Water comes into play the entire right side after the swale to the green.
- Hole #2** Dogleg left. Ideal Tee Shot is a lay-up to the landing area approximately 165 yards, leaving a short iron to a smallish green.
- Hole #4** Ideal tee shot is the left center of the fairway. Approx. 180 yards from tee through the fairway to the water that runs up the right side. Ideal 2nd shot is a lay-up short of the swale, leaving an approach of 150 yards to the green.
- Hole #6** Slight dogleg to the right, but do not get too ambitious on the tee shot, there is plenty of room in the landing area approx. 170 yards from the tee. Watch for water straight ahead through the fairway.
- Hole #7** Dogleg to the right, with hidden water straight away on the tee shot. The ideal tee shot is a fade of about 180-190 yards.
- Hole #9** A great Par 4! With the 2nd pond reachable from the tee, the ideal tee shot is approx. 210 yards. Favor the left side on the tee shot, as the mounds will kick the ball back toward the fairway. Stay away from left and long on approach shot, difficult to get up and down.
- Hole #10** Slight dogleg left. Favor right center of fairway on tee shot. Approx. 140 yard carry over water on tee shot & 270 yards through fairway to the water. Stay away from left side on the approach shot.
- Hole #11** Tee shot should favor left center of fairway, stay away from water on the right side. Approach shot is a tough one to a two-tiered green.
- Hole #12** Slight dogleg to the left. Ideal tee shot is 210 yards to the right side of fairway. Your approach shot must carry water to this small green.
- Hole #13** Tee shot is semi-blind and should favor the left side of the fairway. Do not bite off more than you can chew on this hole! Water on the right & just short of the green.
- Hole #14** Tee shot should favor right side of fairway to set up your 2nd shot on this dogleg left Par 5. Be careful of the 2 Bunkers protecting green.
- Hole #15** Trouble left and right on the tee shot. The pond in front of the green comes into play on the approach shot.
- Hole #17** A sharp dogleg to the left. The ideal tee shot is 165 yards over the directional stake at the top of bank over water. Approx. 200 yards over the stake is o.b.
- Hole #18** Great finishing hole! Ideal tee shot is 190 yards straight at the island green. The water can be reached from the tee, approx. 250 yards, plan accordingly.
- Par 3's** All Par 3's are measured to the middle of the green.
