

**HUNTERS RIDGE GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB  
SOCIAL COMMITTEE MINUTES  
THURSDAY, APRIL 25, 2013**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, John Simoncini, at 2:30pm.

The minutes of the March 25, 2013 meeting were approved.

The following Social Committee members were present: Jacqueline Gannucci, Susan Lewis, David Malenfant, Suzanne Evans-McMurtrie, Sydell Nusbaum, Al Perrotta and Vicki Reilly.

Don Huprich and Chris Durfey were also in attendance. Co-chariman, David Miller was unable to attend due to prior commitment.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

It was agreed that all of the entertainment social events for the months of March and April (Craig and Claudia, Greg Rini, Men's Member Guest- The Manhattan Connection - Marc Vee Band) were well attended and that the entertainment was very good. The one exception was the ventriloquist, Brenda Stelzer. Whereas, she as an entertainer was excellent; the attendance was not good. This could be attributed to the fact that it was held on a non-regular night – Wednesday. Scheduling events on non-traditional evenings will be researched further for the up-coming season.

The Fashion Show was outstanding. We raised \$1,504 for Abused Women. The tentative date for next year is March 7, 2014. The jewelry vendor, You Look Mahvalous, was also very, very good.

The game nights – Trivia, Name That Tune, Bingo – has experienced low attendance. The last game night will be May 5<sup>th</sup> – Trivia. A discussion ensued regarding ideas to bolster attendance. Nothing was resolved or decided regarding that issue. Game Nights will resume in September 2013.

Suzanne Evans-McMurtrie presented an overview of what she could offer the members of Hunters Ridge. She has a plethora of vendors and contacts that could enhance our non-entertainment activities. The Ku Ku Trolley may/will be offered on a Wednesday in May. This is a “trolley” that takes you to a venue – possibly a progressive dinner and/or a pub crawl. All agreed it should be attempted at Hunters Ridge.

We also discussed at length the viability of offering “themed nights” at Hunters Ridge. We agreed to meet in May, when the official calendar should be finalized and schedule themed events for the 2013-2014 season.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

The mission statement was not available. The Board of Directors has not reviewed in totality nor has it been finalized.

John Simoncini reported on entertainers that he has seen. We are contemplating a hypnotist that might do a show at the end of a pub night. We all agreed to try “new things”, but we have to keep in mind that the majority of the members do not want to relinquish pub night.

We made the decision to move a special pub night from September 19 to September 26. We were considering Brylcream Duo, but Sydell Nusbaum wants to investigate Motown Review. She will report back at the next meeting. A big concern, as always, is the cost. It was voted upon and agreed to have the Marc Vee Band for the Dinner Dance on March 29, 2014.

### **SUGGESTIONS/COMMENTS:**

Vicki Reilly inquired about the results of the survey. Don Huprich informed the committee that it is still being reviewed by the Board of Directors. However, he reiterated that one item was quite glaring – PUB NIGHT SHOULD REMAIN PUB NIGHT.

It was suggested that we could offer cocktails and small entertainment once a month on another evening rather than Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday. It will be taken under advisement.

Suzanne Evans McMurtrie will advertise the bus trips for any future ventures. Hunters Ridge will also advertise – a joint venture. We must have a 30 person minimum. We are considering Monday – October 14, 2013 for a bus trip to Miami – “Spanish Roots”. It would cost \$65 pp.

Our next meeting is set for Thursday, May 9, 2013 at 3:00PM.

The meeting adjourned at 3:36PM.
