

HUNTERS RIDGE GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB  
SOCIAL COMMITTEE MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, MAY 25, 2011

Chairman, Michael McNinch called the meeting to order at 4:00PM.

Social Committee members present: Sydell Nusbaum, Cheryl Poostay, Paula Ferrone, and Jackie Gannucci. Susan Lewis and John Simoncini were not present. Don Huprich, General Manager, Chris Durfey, Membership Director, Dave Miller, Board Liaison were also in attendance. Kim Young, Food and Beverage Manager, was not present. Hunters Ridge resident, Janis McNinch was also in attendance.

The minutes of the April 27, 2011 were not readily available. Social Committee members were requested to peruse the minutes on-line. They will be approved at the June meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

April 28 – Special Pub Night with DJ Bernie Green had 50+ members in attendance. It was considered a great evening.

Michael and Elena are scheduled for Thursday, May 26, 2011. There are 60+ reservations to date. There will be a Special Pub Night scheduled as follows for June and July: June 16 – Mirage - July 21 - Bill Killeen.

No performances have been scheduled for August, and as of now, September's performance is TBA.

Don Huprich has been consulting with the Golf Committee to finalize dates and events. He expects to have an official calendar available in 2/3 weeks. At that time, the Social Committee will schedule and finalize the entertainment for the remainder of the year. However, we do have the following major dates and performers: Welcome Back – Cahula and Cream, New Year's Eve – Quiet Storm, St. Patrick's Day – Craig and Claudia, and Aloha – Deb and the Dynamics.

NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion ensued regarding Budget concerns raised by Cheryl Poostay. In summary, the budget covers the calendar year, \$12,000 is budgeted for entertainment purposes only, and we have approximately \$5000 remaining to date. Don Huprich emphasized that we are just where we should be at this time of the year. Don Huprich further stated that the cost of a particular event is not dictated by the cost of the entertainment. That price is based on the food menu, staffing and overhead. He also added that in the future we will probably book the performers ourselves as a cost effective approach.

Cheryl Poostay commented on the possibility of purchasing our own DJ equipment. Cheryl presented research, methods of producing our own music lists, and costs involved in purchasing this equipment. Cheryl also stated that since Hunters Ridge is pursuing improving the sound system that this would be a good time to consider this idea. Chairman, Michael McNinch and the committee thanked Cheryl for her time and efforts to this endeavor.

Cheryl Poostay also was concerned about the inconsistency of offering ½ price drinks on Pub Night. Don Huprich stated that ½ price drinks on Pub Nights would no longer be available. This statement was verified by re-reading the minutes of November 11, 2010. He commented that this was a House Committee decision, and if anyone had questions that these questions should be brought to the House Committee.

#### SUGGESTIONS/COMMENTS

Paula Ferrone requested an update on Grandma's Attic. We were reminded that this will be discussed at a later date with Chris Durfey. Paula Ferrone also suggested the possibility of a garage and/or yard sale. The Master Declaration does not allow these types of sales.

Bingo, Team Trivia, and Name That Tune will not be scheduled until September.

The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, June 29, 2011.

The meeting adjourned at 4:59 PM.
